

CONTESTANT RULES AND REGULATIONS



1. For the Ms. Senior Florida Pageant, contestants must abide by the following rules and regulations as prepared by the pageant committee for the state of Florida.
2. Contestants may be required to participate for the year in promotional photos advertising, TV, radio and other guest appearances as needed. This will be outlined in detail in the following paragraphs
3. Contestants must be 60 years of age or older (The Age of Elegance), and are eligible to participate regardless of her employment, or if she is professional or amateur.
4. Contestants must be resident of Florida for at least 3 months prior to the state contest. Any woman working in the area for more than 3 months is considered eligible.
5. Contestants must be a citizen of the United States of America.
6. Ms. Senior Florida title holder will not participate in any other pageant related competition during her year of reign and understands it will mean forfeiture of her local and state appearances.
7. All appearances and promotions or advertising during the year of reign will be scheduled only by the Pageant Committee. Future schedules will be coordinated with the Committee as well if it relates to the title.
8. No contestant can have any model or talent agency schedule or accept any ads, promotions or commercials for Ms. Senior Florida for the year of her reign except through the arrangements of the Pageant Committee.
9. If contestant is disqualified or unable to carry out the responsibilities of her reign, then the first Runner Up will assume her duties and responsibilities and assume her title. Second, Third and Fourth runners up will be considered in that order.
10. Contestants must be of good character and have the quality of Inner Beauty in her life style. She must possess and display talent in a 2 minute or less talent routine which may not include film, fire, animals or another person.
11. Each contestant is to be furnished with the same type of lighting, mikes, script introduction and facilities as received by all other contestants while competing for the State title.

12. Contestants must furnish the State Pageant Committee with the following:
 - a. Application fee - \$200.00 (Cashier Check or Money Order only) NON REFUNDABLE
The first 50 completed applications with Application Fee will be accepted as contestants
 - b. Contestants must commit to sell ten (10) admission tickets to the Pageant
 - c. Digital photo head shot on a CD by your photographer. Or the Pageant photographer can take your picture at the first rehearsal. Check is to be made out to the photographer for \$50.00 and a digital photo will be given to the Pageant on a CD.
 - d. Indicate the type of Talent and Music you intend to perform.
 - e. Copy of music or CD, if needed.
 - f. Must attend first introduction meeting
 - g. Must return or bring your application packet to first meeting
 - h. Must submit Model Photo Release Agreement
 - i. Contestants are required to sign all release forms prior to rehearsals
 - j. Must bring to first rehearsal a written copy of your Philosophy of Life – 35 seconds in length
 - k. Must bring to first rehearsal a copy of your Biography
 - l. Must bring to first rehearsal photo ID for proof of age.
13. Contestants may be required to participate in any photos, personal appearances, promotions, commercials and interviews are arranged by the Pageant Committee. Winner can continue to participate through future years with the Pageant, and participate each year in the Pageant.
